Visa application

WMM26 participants who are required to apply for visa to enter China can apply for a Chinese visa at the nearest Embassy or Consulate of China in your countries. For some visa applications, the process could take some time to complete, depending on your country of origin and certain visa restrictions so we would like to suggest you start the visa application as early as possible. For participants who need the official invitation letter for visa application, please log in your account and download it in "My Page" after paying the registration fee.

Tips: Local organizers could NOT provide conference invitation letter to accompanying personnel according to related regulations. We suggest that accompanying people apply for tourism type visa, which will be much easier and require less paperwork.

Notes:

1. You should guarantee that all information provided is true and correct.
2. In the letter for visa, we can only guarantee your stay in Beijing during the conference.
3. General visa information should be obtained from your local Embassy or Consulate of China.

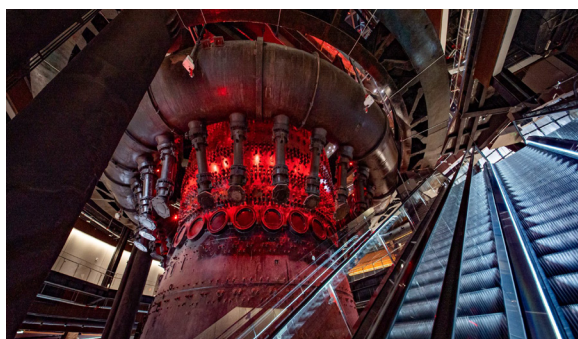
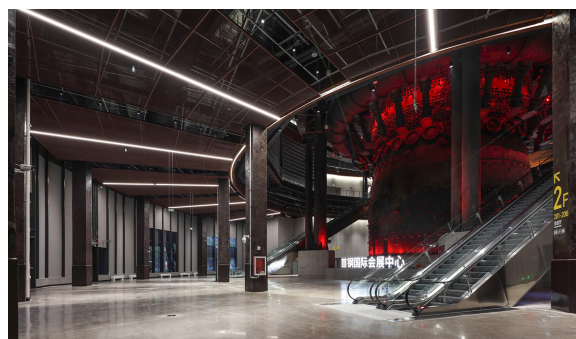
Conference venue

The 12th International Conference Magnetism and Metallurgy WMM'26 will take place in Beijing at:

Shougang Park

No.68 Shijingshan Rd, Beijing

Shougang Park was included in the first batch of pilot areas for the transformation of old industrial areas in urban areas in China, national pilot areas for the comprehensive reform of the service industry, national sustainable development pilot areas, Zhongguancun national independent innovation demonstration areas, national smart city pilot areas and Beijing green ecological demonstration areas. It is the first C40 positive climate model area in China. The official entry of the Beijing Organizing Committee for the 2022 Winter Olympic and Paralympic Games in 2016 was a milestone in the development of Shougang Park.



In the past six years, Shougang Park has made breakthroughs in urban renewal with its Olympics projects, seized the opportunity of the Winter Olympic Games, focused on "cultural, industrial, ecological and vitality rejuvenation", and promoted the comprehensive completion of New Shougang Area's "Three-year Action Plan". Its infrastructure carrying capacity and environmental quality have significantly improved, high-end elements have quickly gathered and innovation vitality has been initially released. The construction of new landmarks for urban rejuvenation has achieved initial results and positive social responses. Shougang Park has become a classic case of urban renewal driven by the Olympic Movement in the world.



How to reach

Arrival by taxi



From Beijing Daxing Airport

It is about 67 kilometers and takes around 1 hour and 15 minutes, with a cost of roughly 200 yuan.

From Beijing Capital Airport

It is around 54 kilometers takes about 100 minutes. with a cost of roughly 150 yuan.

Arrival by Metro



From Beijing Daxing Airport

Take the Daxing Airport Line to Caoying Station. Transfer to Line 19 (Mudanyuan Direction) to Ping'anli Station, then transfer to Line 6 towards Jin'anqiao Station, and get off at Jin'anqiao Station. Exit from K of Jin'anqiao Station and walk for about 10 minutes to reach Shougang Park. It is about 1 hour 30 minutes and the fare is about 41 yuan.

From Beijing Capital Airport

Take the Airport Express to Sanyuanqiao Station (Beixinqiao Direction), transfer to Line 10 to Hujialou Station (Liangmaqiao Direction), then transfer to Line 6 to Jin'anqiao Station. Exit from K and walk about 10 mins to Shougang Park. It is about 1 hour 40 minutes and the fare is about 31 yuan.



Proposed accommodation

Shangri-La Hotel (★★★★★)

Shangri-La Hotel is next to the conference venue and it is also recommended hotel. The New Shougang High-end Industry Comprehensive Service Area (often referred to as the Shougang Park) is where natural beauty and man-made industry structures are perfectly merged. The Shougang Park is named "Renewal Model for Cities with an Industrial Heritage" and a "New Landmark of Beijing's Urban Renaissance."
